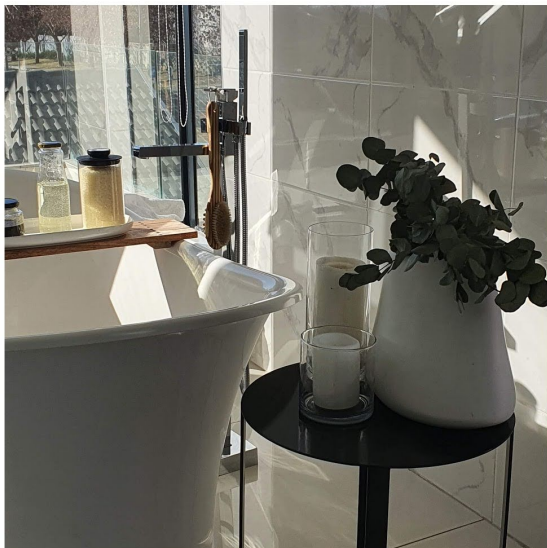
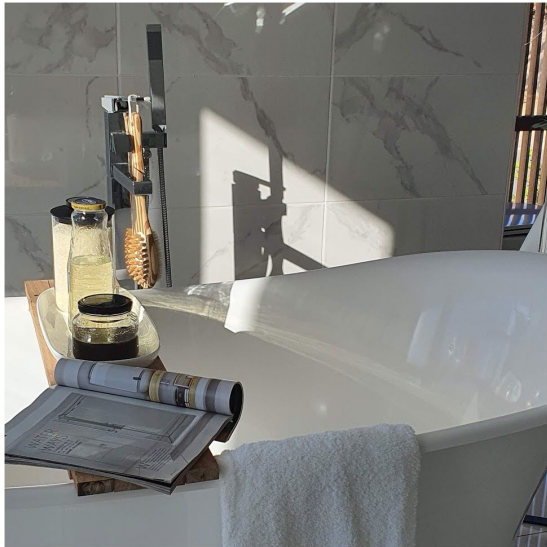


Creating a Luxurious Bathroom
